On August 8, 2018 at 2:04pm, officers arrested Louis Spaulding, 46, no fixed address, for Second Degree Assault, Class B Felony and Change of Registration Information; Duty to Inform, Class B Felony.

On July 24, 2018 at 11:44pm, officers responded to the bike path behind the Nashua Public Library for the report of an assault. The victim reported that Spaulding had assaulted him. An arrest warrant was issued for Spaulding charging him with Second Degree Assault, Class B Felony. During the investigation it was discovered Spaulding had failed to inform on his change in residence within the required timeframe.

A Class B Felony is punishable by up to 7 years imprisonment, exclusive of fines. Spaulding was held on a \$25,000.00 cash/surety bail and is scheduled to be arraigned at the Hillsborough County Superior Court-South on August 9, 2018.
