On February 21, 2018, members of the Nashua Police Department's Narcotics Intelligence Division, Problem Oriented Policing Unit and Traffic Unit conducted another operation as part of the Granite Shield program and arrested Arthur Voutselas, Age 26, of 25 Robinson Road, Nashua. Voutselas was charged with two counts of Acts Prohibited, Sale of a Controlled Drug, Cocaine, Second Offense, Felony; one count of Acts Prohibited, Possession of a Controlled Drug with Intent to Distribute, Fentanyl, Second Offense, Felony; one count of Possession of a Controlled Drug, Fentanyl, Second Offense, Felony; one count of Possession of a Controlled Drug, Oxycodone, Second Offense, Felony; and one count of Possession of a Controlled Drug, Anabolic Steroids, Second Offense, Felony.

A search of Voutselas's residence led to the recovery of over 50 grams of suspected fentanyl and approximately 13,000 dollars in U.S. Currency. Voutselas will face enhanced penalties for having a prior drug offense and being in possession of the above quantity of fentanyl. Voutselas was held on \$200,000 cash bail pending his arraignment in Hillsborough County Superior Court-South on February 22, 2018.

This arrest came at the conclusion of an extensive investigation into the distribution of illegal drugs in Nashua and was made possible through funding provided by the Granite Shield program.
