On September 01, 2021 at approximately 4:29PM, members from the Nashua Police Department's Uniformed Patrol Division arrested Randy Hall, age 47, of 170 East Dunstable Road, Nashua, New Hampshire, for Second Degree Assault.

Earlier in the day on September 01, 2021, the Nashua Police Department received information regarding an assault of a juvenile victim by an adult male that was known to him. The juvenile victim did not sustain serious bodily injury from the assault. The investigation was furthered by detectives assigned to the Special Investigations Division and Hall was identified as a suspect. As a result of the investigation, detectives completed an arrest warrant charging Hall with one count of Second Degree Assault, a Class B Felony. Hall was then taken into custody without incident.

A Class B Felony is punishable up to 7 ½ years in State Prison, exclusive of fines. Hall was held on preventative detention pending his arraignment in the Hillsborough County Superior Court-Southern District on September 02, 2021.
