On December 7, 2017, members of the Nashua Police Department's Narcotics Intelligence Division, Problem Oriented Policing Unit, and Traffic Unit participated in Operation Granite Shield where five individuals were arrested for various drug crimes, and various crimes frequently associated with criminal behavior related to drug activity. These individuals were: Karl Saunders, Hunter Phillips, Tyler Bott, Katherine Price and Nelson Devarie.

Karl Saunders, age 34, of 42 Yarmouth Drive Street, Nashua, NH was arrested on December 6, 2017 and charged with Violation of Probation and Parole. Saunders was held without bail and is scheduled for arraignment on December 7, 2017.

Hunter Phillips, age 23, of No Fixed Address, Nashua, NH was arrested on December 6, 2017 and charged with Acts Prohibited; Sale of a Controlled Drug, Heroin, Felony, Acts Prohibited; Possession of a Controlled Drug, Suboxone, Felony, and Acts Prohibited; Possession of a Controlled Drug, Crack Cocaine, Felony. Phillips was held on \$25,000 cash bail and is scheduled for arraignment on December 7, 2017.

Tyler Bott, age 23, of 21 Spalding Avenue, Nashua, NH was arrested on December 6, 2017 and charged with an Electronic Bench Warrant as well as an Out of Town Arrest Warrant stemming from a Theft by Unauthorized Taking of a Firearm. Bott was released to an outside agency and will be arraigned on a future date.

Katherine Price, age 27, of 29 Kinsley Street, Nashua, NH was arrested on December 6, 2017 and charged with Acts Prohibited; Possession of a Controlled Drug, Heroin, Felony. Price was released on \$2,500 personal recognizance bail and is scheduled for arraignment on December 21, 2017.

Nelson Devarie, 52 of, of 10 Marie Avenue, Nashua, NH was arrested on December 6, 2017 and charged with a Capias Warrant stemming from an Acts Prohibited; Possession of a Controlled Drug charge. Devarie was held on \$800 cash bail and is scheduled for arraignment on December 7, 2017.

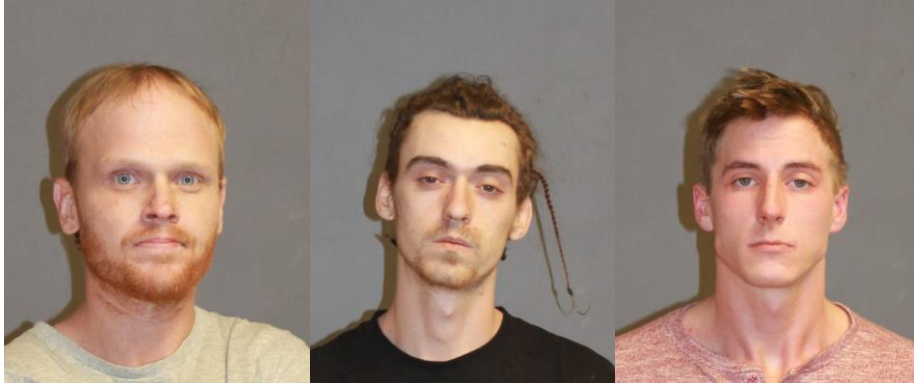
