On Friday, April 6, 2018 at approximately 7:07pm, officers arrested Eilish Murtagh-Fales, age 35, of 102 Brookline Street, Townsend, Massachusetts, on a Nashua Police Department warrant, charging her with Theft of Lost or Mislaid Property, Class B Felony.

On December 28, 2017 patrol officers responded to a local Starbucks for a report of a theft of mislaid property. The victim reported inadvertently leaving their wallet within the business. Due to the value of the contents, the theft constituted a felony. The Criminal Investigations Division furthered the investigation and identified Murtagh-Fales as the suspect responsible for the theft.

A Class B Felony is punishable by up to seven years imprisonment, exclusive of fines. Murtagh-Fales was released on \$500.00 cash bail and will be arraigned at the Hillsborough County Superior Court South on April 19, 2018.
