On Monday April 17, 2017 at approximately 5:30 pm, members of the Uniform Patrol Division arrested Judith Erickson, age 56, of 4 Woodbury Drive, Nashua, New Hampshire on a warrant for Theft by Deception (Consolidation), Class A Felony.

On March 20, 2017 the owner of the Michael Timothy Dining Group reported that the company's human resources manager, identified as Judith Erickson, had been stealing from the company since June 2016. Patrol officers learned that Erickson had stolen over \$2,000.00 from the company by altering her healthcare coverage status during payroll periods.

The Criminal Investigation Division was notified of this incident and furthered the investigation. Detectives obtained an arrest warrant charging Erickson with one count of Theft by Deception (Consolidation), Class A Felony.

A Class A Felony is punishable by up to fifteen (15) years imprisonment, exclusive of fines. Erickson was released on \$250.00 cash bail and will be arraigned at the 9<sup>th</sup> Circuit-District Division-Nashua Court on June 5, 2017.
