On December 4, 2017 at approximately 1:36pm, members of the Nashua Police Department's Uniform Field Operations Bureau responded to TD Bank at 10 Gusabel Avenue for the report of a robbery. The investigation revealed that a male entered the bank, passed a note to a teller and demanded money. The suspect fled with an undisclosed amount of cash in a red pickup truck bearing Connecticut registration 730ZYN. The registration does not come back registered to the red pickup truck. There were no reported injuries.

Detectives with the Nashua Police Department's Criminal Investigation Division furthered the investigation and identified the suspect as Zachary Provost, age 32, whose was last known to reside in Connecticut. An arrest warrant was obtained charging Provost with Robbery. His whereabouts at this time are unknown. Provost is also wanted in connection with crimes that occurred in Connecticut within the previous week.

Provost is described as a white male, 6'3" tall, 175 lbs., with blue eyes, brown hair and a goatee. Provost has multiple tattoos including a star on both the right and left side of his neck. He was last seen wearing a CAT ball cap, an American Eagle brand hooded sweatshirt, jeans and boots. The red pickup truck is a single cab style with a back rack guard.
