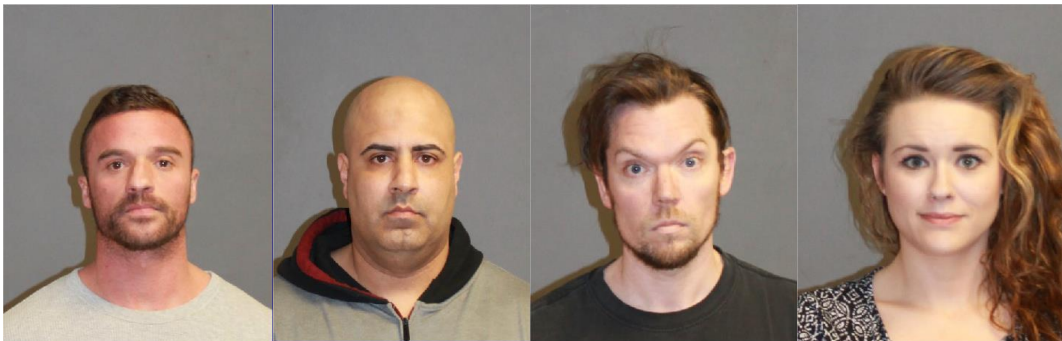
On March 28th and 29th, 2017 members of the Nashua Police Department's Narcotics Intelligence Division, Problem Oriented Policing Unit, and Traffic Unit conducted a Granite Hammer operation which four individuals were arrested for various felony level drug offenses. These individuals were: Christopher Tremblay, Geraldo Arroyo-Oquendo, Christopher Obryan, and Jamie Stauffer-Alurie.

Christopher Tremblay, age 37, of 38 Ponderosa Ave, Nashua, N.H., was charged with two counts Sale of Controlled Drug, Oxycodone, Felony. Tremblay is currently being held on \$50,000 cash bail pending his arraignment on March 29, 2017.

Geraldo Arroyo-Oquendo, age 43, of 6 Pulpit Place, was charged with one count Sale of Controlled Drug, Crack Cocaine, Second Offense, Felony and Possession of Controlled Drug with Intent to Distribute, Crack Cocaine, Second Offense, Felony. A search warrant was executed on his vehicle where approximately 49 grams of crack cocaine was also located. Arroyo-Oquendo refused bail and he was scheduled to be arraigned on March 29, 2017.

Christopher Obryan, age 32, of 13 Perkins Place, Wilder, Vermont was charged with one count Sale of Controlled Drug, Heroin, Felony. Obryan is currently being held on \$25,000 cash bail and he was scheduled to be arraigned on March 30, 2017.

Jamie Stauffer-Alurie, age 30, of 8 Brown Street, Enfield, New Hampshire was charged with one count Criminal Liability to the Sale of Controlled Drug, Heroin, Felony. Stauffer-Alurie is currently being held on \$15,000 cash bail and she was scheduled to be arraigned on March 30, 2017.

All defendants will be arraigned at the 9th Circuit Nashua District Division Nashua Court. A Felony is punishable by a term of imprisonment at the State Prison, exclusive of fines. A misdemeanor is punishable by up to one year imprisonment at the county jail, exclusive of fines.
