On May 1, 2017 at approximately 8:17 PM, Patrick MacDonald, age 32, of 1108 Center Street Middleborough, Massachusetts was placed under arrest and charged with Stalking, Class B Felony.

On April 29, 2017 at approximately 10:00 AM, patrol officers from the Nashua Police Department's Uniform Field Operations Bureau responded to an address in Nashua for a report of a Violation of a Stalking Order. A female, known to MacDonald, reported that MacDonald contacted her through email in violation of a Stalking Final Order of Protection.

Upon review of MacDonald's criminal history, it was determined he was previously convicted of Stalking in March 2017 out of the 9<sup>th</sup> Circuit District Division Nashua Court in March 2017. Based on that conviction, any subsequent offense qualifies as a felony. The investigation was referred to Detectives assigned to the Special Investigations Division for furtherance. Based on their investigation, detectives applied for and were granted an arrest warrant for MacDonald for Stalking, Class B Felony.

MacDonald was arrested on May 1, 2017 by the Middleborough, MA Police Department. MacDonald waived extradition at the Wareham, MA District Court and his custody was transferred to the Nashua Police Department.

A Class B Felony is punishable by up to seven years in State Prison, exclusive of fines. MacDonald was not eligible for bail at the time of his arrest and was held at the Hillsborough County Department of Corrections. He was arraigned at the 9<sup>th</sup> Circuit District Division Nashua Court on May 2, 2017.
