On July 11, 2018 at approximately 1:59 P.M., officers from the Nashua Police Department's Uniformed Field Operations Bureau arrested Douglas Solberg, age 45, of 47 Dorchester Way Nashua, New Hampshire on a warrant for Tampering with Witnesses and Informants, Class B Felony.

On July 2, 2018 at approximately 4:34 P.M., officers responded to the Nashua Police Department where they received the report of a subject not complying with a civil order. The reporting party advised that she filed a motion for contempt and Solberg continued to contact her trying to convince her not to proceed with the court hearing. The investigation was furthered by Detectives from the Nashua Police Department's Special Investigations Division and an arrest warrant for Solberg was obtained. Solberg was charged with one count of Tampering with Witnesses and Informants, Class B Felony.

A Class B Felony is punishable by up to seven years in State Prison, exclusive of fines. Solberg was released on \$250.00 cash bail pending his arraignment at the Hillsborough Superior Court Southern District on July 26, 2018.
