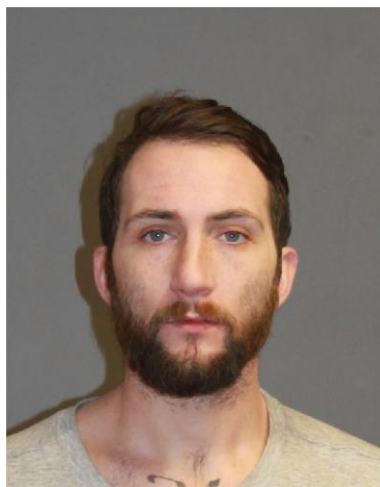

On January 3, 2018 at approximately 12:33 PM, officers arrested Jonathan Amorella Moore, 28, of No Fixed Address, Nashua, New Hampshire, on a warrant for Burglary, Class B Felony. He was additionally charged with two more counts of Burglary, Class B Felony, and one count of Receiving Stolen Property, Class A Felony.

On October 25, 2017 and November 6, 2017, officers responded to local residences for the report of two separate burglaries. The detectives from the Criminal Investigation Division then furthered the investigation, and Jonathan Amorella Moore was determined to be the suspect for each burglary. An arrest warrant for Burglary was then obtained for Amorella Moore, and he was arrested on the warrant. On the date of his arrest, it was learned that Amorella Moore had committed another residential burglary earlier in the day.

A Class A Felony is punishable by up to 15 years imprisonment, exclusive of fines, and a Class B Felony is punishable by up to 7 years imprisonment exclusive of fines. Amorella Moore is being held on \$35,000.00 cash bail at the Hillsborough County Department of Corrections in Manchester, NH pending his arraignment at the Hillsborough County Superior Court-South on January 4, 2018.
