On June 26, 2017 at 8:42pm members from the Nashua Police Department's Detective Bureau and Uniform Field Operations Bureau arrested Paul Labrecque, age 31, of 42 Gendron Street. Labrecque was arrested on a warrant for Reckless Conduct, Class B Felony.

On June 23, 2017 at 11:58 pm, patrol officers from the Uniform Field Operations Bureau received a report of an adult male who fired gunshots in the area of Gendron Street and Old Coach Road in Nashua. Several juveniles reported they were confronted by a male subject after one of them broke some glass on Gendron Street. The male verbally confronted them and the juveniles left the area. The male then followed the juveniles in a vehicle and fired several rounds from a firearm within 50 feet of the juveniles who ran and hid from the armed subject. None of the juveniles were injured.

Once the Nashua Police were notified of the incident, Detectives from the Special Investigations Division were assigned to further the investigation. Paul Labrecque was developed and identified as a suspect. Detectives applied for and were granted an arrest warrant for Labrecque charging him with Reckless Conduct, Class B Felony, and he was arrested on June 26, 2017.

A Class B Felony is punishable by up to seven years in State Prison, exclusive of fines. Labrecque was held on \$25,000 Cash/Surety bail and is due for arraignment at the 9<sup>th</sup> Circuit Court District of Nashua on June 27<sup>th</sup> 2017.
