On July 27, 2017 at approximately 10:22 PM members of the Nashua Police Department's Uniform Field Operations Bureau arrested David Campbell, age 32, no fixed address, Nashua, New Hampshire on a warrant for Criminal Threatening, Class B Felony.

On July 2, 2017 at approximately 8:11 PM, the Nashua Police Department was notified of a domestic incident that just took place in Nashua. Officers responded and spoke with an adult male who had been in a prior romantic relationship with Campbell. The male reported that Campbell confronted him and threatened him with a knife. Based on the nature of the offense, detectives with the Special Investigations Division were notified.

Following an investigation, detectives applied for and were granted a warrant for Campbell's arrest. On July 27, 2017 Campbell was located and arrested by the Exeter New Hampshire Police Department on the Nashua warrant and brought to the Rockingham County Jail. Officers from the Nashua Police Patrol Division responded to the Rockingham County Jail and took custody of Campbell. Campbell was brought back to the Nashua Police Department and the charge of Domestic Violence – Criminal Threatening, Class B Felony was added when he was booked.

A Class B Felony is punishable by up to seven years in State Prison, exclusive of fines. Campbell is being held on \$3,000.00 cash only bail pending his arraignment at the 9<sup>th</sup> Circuit-District Division-Nashua Court on Jul 28, 2017.
