On November 26, 2018 officers from the Nashua Police Department's Uniform Field Operations Bureau arrested Jesse Belt, age 37, of No Fixed Address for two counts of Second Degree Assault – Domestic Violence, Class B Felony and one count of Simple Assault – Domestic Violence, Class A Misdemeanor.

On April 9, 2018 the Nashua Police Department received a law enforcement letter from the Department of Children Youth and Families involving several alleged assaults of a juvenile. The juvenile and Belt are known to one another. Detectives in the Special Investigations Division furthered the investigation and an arrest warrant was obtained for Belt.

A Class B Felony is punishable up to 7 years in State Prison, exclusive of fines. A Class A Misdemeanor is punishable up to 1 year in the County House of Corrections, exclusive of fines. Belt was released on \$5,000 Cash or Surety bail. He is scheduled to be arraigned at the 9<sup>th</sup> Circuit Nashua District Division Court on December 13, 2018.
