On June 14, 2022, members of the Nashua Police Department's Problem Oriented Policing Unit arrested Corrine Nurse-Sherrod, age 27, of 337 St. Paul Street #2, Brookline, Massachusetts on an outstanding warrant for Theft by Unauthorized Taking (Acting in Concert), a Class B Felony. She was also charged with an additional count of Theft by Unauthorized Taking (Acting in Concert), a Class A Felony.

On several dates between October of 2021 and April of 2022, members of the Nashua Police Department's Uniformed Field Operations Bureau responded to multiple businesses at the Pheasant Lane Mall for the report of thefts. Detectives with the Nashua Police Department's Criminal Investigation Division furthered the investigations and identified Corrine Nurse-Sherrod as being involved in stealing items that totaled in excess of \$1,000.00 and \$1,500.00 on multiple occasions. An arrest warrant was sought and granted, charging her with Theft by Unauthorized Taking (Acting in Concert), a Class B Felony.

A Class A Felony is punishable by up to fifteen years in state prison, exclusive of fines and a Class B Felony is punishable by up to seven years in state prison, exclusive of fines. Nurse-Sherrod was released on a \$300.00 cash bail and will be arraigned in the Hillsborough County Superior Court – South on a date to be determined.
