The Nashua Police Department's Special Investigations Division recently conducted an investigation into online activity that involved identifying individuals who targeted juveniles for sexual activity and arrested two individuals.

On July 21, 2017 at approximately 10:00am the Nashua Police Department arrested Dana Avery, age 53, of 40A Washington Street, Rochester, NH, and charged him with three counts of Certain Uses of Computer Services Prohibited, Class B Felony. Avery communicated online with someone who he believed was a fourteen year old female from Nashua. The person Avery actually communicated with was a Nashua Detective. Hundreds of messages were exchanged between the two. On multiple occasions Avery stated he wanted to engage in sexual activity with the juvenile female he believed was fourteen years old. On July 21, 2017 Avery traveled to Nashua to meet the juvenile and was arrested by Nashua Police. Avery's bail was set at \$15,000.00 cash only. Avery is scheduled for a probable cause hearing on September 25, 2017 at 8:15am in the 9th Circuit - District Division - Nashua Court.

On August 4, 2017 at 12:13pm the Nashua Police Department arrested Alexander Del More, age 30, of 555 South Commercial Street Apt. 405, Manchester, NH and charged him with three counts of Certain Uses of Computer Services Prohibited, Class B Felony and Endangering the Welfare of a Child or Incompetent, Class B Felony. Del More communicated with someone he believed was a fifteen year old female from Nashua. The person Del More actually communicated with was a Nashua Detective. Hundreds of messages were exchanged between the two. On multiple occasions Del More stated he wanted to engage in sexual activity with the juvenile he believed was fifteen years old. On August 4, 2017 Del More traveled to Nashua to

meet the juvenile and was arrested by Nashua Police. Del More's bail was set at \$5000.00 cash only. Del More is scheduled to appear in the 9th Circuit - District Division - Nashua Court on August 17, 2017 at 8:15am for a probable cause hearing.

The Nashua Police Department's Special Investigation Division was assisted by the Patrol Division, the Narcotics Division and the Computer Forensic Unit. The Rochester NH Police Department and the Manchester NH Police Department also provided assistance. Nashua Police Department is affiliated with the New Hampshire Internet Crimes Against Children Task Force (ICAC). Each Class B Felony is punishable by up to seven years in State Prison, exclusive of fines.
