On August 11, 2017 at 10:55 pm, officers from the Nashua Police Department's Uniform Field Operations Bureau responded to 46 Bay Ridge Drive, Apartment I, Nashua, NH in attempt to locate an 18 year old female whose family was concerned for her. Upon arrival officers located the female and determined she was in need of medical assistance. Officers requested an ambulance and the female was transported to a Nashua hospital for treatment. Officers placed David Greenblatt, age 46, under arrest for Prohibited Sales of Alcohol, class A Misdemeanor and Disorderly Conduct, class A Misdemeanor. Greenblatt was released on \$200.00 cash/surety bail.

The investigation was furthered by Detectives assigned to the Special Investigations Division. Through the course of the investigation it was determined the female was sexually assaulted by Greenblatt. Based on the information, detectives applied for and were granted an arrest warrant for Greenblatt for Aggravated Felonious Sexual Assault. On August 25, 2017 at 1:29 pm Greenblatt was arrested by patrol officers on the warrant and he was charged with two counts of Aggravated Felonious Sexual Assault, Class B Felony.

Greenblatt's bail was set at \$100,000.00 cash only. Greenblatt was held at the Hillsborough County Department of Corrections and he will be arraigned at the 9th Circuit Court, Nashua District Division on August 28, 2017. A Class A Felony is punishable by up to fifteen years in State Prison, exclusive of fines. A Class A Misdemeanor is punishable by up to one year in the Hillsborough County House of Correction, exclusive of fines.
