On April 11th, 2017 at approximately 5:00 AM, officers from the Nashua Police Department's Uniform Field Operations Bureau, Patrol Division, arrested Peter Lachapelle, age 43, of 30 Ledge Street Apt. 3, Nashua, New Hampshire on a warrant for Second Degree Assault - Domestic Violence, Class B Felony.

On March 10th, 2017, the Nashua Police Department received a report from a female who stated she was assaulted by her boyfriend, Peter Lachapelle, at a Nashua residence. The female reported that Lachapelle strangled her during an argument. The female also reported that Lachapelle assaulted her multiple times when he threw her around the residence, threatened her and that Lachapelle damaged her property. The female sustained non-life threatening injuries from the assault and was treated at a local hospital. Detectives from the Special Investigations Division were notified and furthered the investigation.

On March 11th, 2017 Detectives applied for and were granted an arrest warrant for Lachapelle for Second Degree Assault - Domestic Violence, Class B Felony. On April 11, 2017 at approximately 4:45 AM Lachapelle was located by patrol officers on Factory Street in Nashua and placed under arrest on the warrant. Based on the investigation, Lachapelle was also charged with Second Degree Assault, Class B Felony; five counts of Simple Assault - Domestic Violence, Class A Misdemeanor; five counts of Simple Assault, Class A Misdemeanor; three counts of Criminal Mischief, Class A Misdemeanor and Criminal Threatening, Class A Misdemeanor.

Each Class B Felony is punishable by up to seven years in State Prison, exclusive of fines. Each Class A Misdemeanor is punishable up to one year in the County House of Corrections, exclusive of fines. Lachapelle is being held at Valley Street Jail on \$5,000 cash bail pending his arraignment at the 9th Circuit - District Division - Nashua Court on April 12th, 2017.
