On January 10, 2017 at approximately 7:10 pm members of the Nashua Police Department's Special Investigations Division arrested Ronald Duby, age 43, of No Fixed Address, Nashua, New Hampshire for Duty to Report, Class A Felony and Duty to Inform, Class A Felony.

In March of 1995 Ronald Duby was convicted of two counts of Felony Sexual Assault on a victim under the age of 16 and one count of Felony Lewd-Lascivious Conduct with a Child in Windsor County, Vermont. Based on his convictions, Duby is required to register quarterly as a Tier III Sex Offender.

Additionally, Duby was convicted in 2009 of multiple counts of Duty to Inform and Duty to Report, Class B Felonies, in Grafton County Superior Court. In 2012 Duby was convicted of Duty to Inform, Class A Felony in Grafton County Superior Court.

In December 2016, Duby was released on bail from a Capias issued out of Hillsborough South Superior Court that stemmed from a February 2016 arrest by the Nashua Police Department for Duty to Inform, Class A Felony. Duby was directed by the Court to register with the Nashua Police Department upon his release on December 6, 2016. As of January 10, 2017 Duby had not responded to the Nashua Police Department to complete his Sex Offender Registration as ordered by the court and became non-compliant. Detectives from the Special Investigations Division furthered the investigation and determined Duby failed to comply with the terms of the New Hampshire Sex Offender Registry. Detectives located Duby at Mary's House, 123 West Pearl Street, Nashua, NH and placed him under arrest.

The offenses are charged as a Class A Felonies based on Duby's prior convictions for Duty to Report.

A Class A Felony is punishable by up to fifteen years imprisonment, exclusive of fines, for each count. Duby was held on bail pending his arraignment at the 9th Circuit-District Division-Nashua Court.
