On September 28, 2021, members from the Nashua Police Department's Uniform Field Operations Bureau arrested Timothy Bouley, age 46, of Dracut, Massachusetts, on a warrant charging him with Second Degree Assault (Strangulation)-Domestic Violence, Class B Felony.

On September 2, 2021, the Nashua Police Department received a report of a domestic incident involving Bouley and an adult female known to him. The investigation was furthered by Officers assigned to the Domestic Violence Unit of the Special Investigations Division. During the investigation, it was determined Bouley had committed numerous Domestic Violence related offenses and an arrest warrant was obtained. Bouley was charged with Second Degree Assault (Strangulation) - Domestic Violence, Class B Felony, two counts of Domestic Violence: Simple Assault, Class A Misdemeanor, Domestic Violence: False Imprisonment, Class A Misdemeanor, Domestic Violence: Obstructing the Report of a Crime, Class A Misdemeanor, Criminal Mischief, Class A Misdemeanor, and Criminal Threatening, Class A Misdemeanor.

A Class B Felony is punishable up to 7 ½ years in State Prison, exclusive of fines. A Class A Misdemeanor is punishable up to 1 year in the County House of Corrections, exclusive of fines. Bouley is being held at the Hillsborough County House of Corrections in Manchester, New Hampshire pending his arraignment at the Hillsborough County Superior Court-Southern District on September 29, 2021.
