On January 5, 2017 at approximately 2:03pm members of the Nashua Police Department's Problem Oriented Policing Unit arrested Jonathan Felch, 34, of LKA 189 Green Street Apartment 2 Manchester, New Hampshire. He was charged with Theft by Unauthorized Taking or Transfer, Class A Felony.

On December 16, 2016 at 8:24am, the Nashua Police Department received a report of stolen tools from a trailer located at 15 Marmon Drive, a new site for Infiniti of Nashua. The tools were valued in excess of \$5,000 Dollars. On January 4, 2017 one of the tools, a Rigid hydraulic pipe cutter, was located on Craigslist.com by the owner. Detectives were notified of the tool being advertised on Craigslist, and worked in conjunction with the Problem Oriented Policing Unit to locate the property.

During the course of the investigation, the Problem Oriented Policing Unit made contact with the subject advertising the pipe cutter on Craigslist and arranged to purchase it. The subject who was ultimately identified as Felch agreed to sell the pipe cutter and the pipe cutter was recovered. A warrant for Felch's arrest was issued and he was subsequently arrested on January 5, 2017.

Felch is being held on \$2,500 Cash or Surety bail and is scheduled for arraignment at the 9th Circuit – District Division – Nashua Court on January 6, 2017. A Class A Felony is punishable of up to fifteen years in State Prison, exclusive of fines.
