On May 4, 2017 members of the Nashua Police Department's Narcotics Intelligence Division, Problem Oriented Policing Unit and Traffic Enforcement Unit conducted another Granite Hammer Operation where eight individuals were arrested for drug-related crimes. These individuals were:

Stephanie Thompson, age 26, of 32 Willow St. Apt A in Nashua, was charged with one count of Acts Prohibited, Sale of a Controlled Drug-Oxycodone Hydrochloride, felony. Thompson was held on \$25,000 cash bail.

Trek Stapel, age 27, of 89 ½ Palm St. #2, in Nashua, was charged with one count of Common Nuisance, felony. Stapel was held on \$100,000 cash bail.

Enric Podvojsky, age 45, of 43 Northwood Dr. in Nashua, was charged with one count of Acts Prohibited, Sale of a Controlled Drug-Crack Cocaine. Podvojsky was held on \$25,000 cash bail.

Edwin Hernandez, age 43, of 237 Main Street Apt. 6 in Nashua, was charged with one count of Falsifying Physical Evidence. Hernandez was held on \$10,000 cash bail.

Damien Martini, age 34, of 15 Woodland Drive, in Nashua, was charged with two counts of Acts Prohibited, Sale of a Controlled Drug Heroin Second Offense. Martini refused bail.

Israel Santiago, age 42, with no fixed address was charged with Acts Prohibited, Sale of a Controlled Drug Crack Cocaine and Sale of a Controlled Drug Cocaine. Santiago refused bail.

Erica Barlow, age 26, with no fixed address was charged with Resisting Arrest, Criminal Trespass and a series of Bench Warrants that stemmed from a previous Granite Hammer Operation that resulted in Barlow being charged with Acts Prohibited, Sale of a Controlled Drug Heroin. Barlow is being held pending arraignment.

Crysal Gately, age 28, of 6 Summit St, Woburn, MA, was charged with one count of Acts Prohibited, Possession of a Controlled Drug Suboxone. Gately was held on \$540 cash bail.
