On Tuesday, March 12, 2019 at approximately 1:14 p.m., members of the Uniform Field Operations Bureau arrested Christopher Hopf, age 40, of 30 Lancaster Road, Shirley, Massachusetts, on a warrant issued by the Nashua Police Department for Theft by Deception, Class A Felony.

On October 16, 2018, officers responded to Boston Billiard Club and Casino, 55 Northeastern Boulevard, for the report of an employee theft. It was reported that Hopf, a dealer at the casino, was manipulating the cards in a card game, which produced a winning hand. The Criminal Investigation Division furthered the investigation, determining that Hopf had committed the theft. Additionally, it was learned that Hopf acted in concert with one of the players, who benefitted financially from the fraudulent card dealing. Warrants were issued for theft for both subjects.

A Class A Felony is punishable by up to fifteen years imprisonment, exclusive of fines. Hopf was released from custody on his own personal recognizance. Hopf is scheduled for arraignment at the Hillsborough County Superior Court South on March 21, 2019.
