On November 22, 2021 at approximately 2:15 AM, members of the Nashua Police Department's Uniform Field Operations Bureau arrested Terrance Portinari, age 22, of Pittsfield, New Hampshire, for Domestic Violence – Reckless Conduct (Deadly Weapon).

On November 22, 2021 at approximately 1:49 AM, patrol officers were dispatched to a Nashua motel for the report of shots fired. It was reported a male, later identified as Portinari, shot through the wall of his hotel room. The bullet travelled into an adjoining room. There were several guests in Portinari's room, to include his two year old child, and in the adjoining room. No one was injured during the incident. Detectives from the Special Investigations Division furthered the investigation, subsequently charging Portinari with Domestic Violence – Reckless Conduct (Deadly Weapon), Class B Felony, two counts of Reckless Conduct (Deadly Weapon), Class B Felony and Endangering Welfare of Child, Class A Misdemeanor.

A Class B Felony is punishable up to 7-years in State Prison, exclusive of fines. A Class A Misdemeanor is punishable by up to 1-year in the County House of Corrections, exclusive of fines. Portinari was held on preventative detention, pending his arraignment at the Hillsborough County Superior Court-South on November 23, 2021 at 1:00 PM.
